DISCUSSION ITEMS

CALL TO ORDER

- The Campus Director and Acting Chair, Dr. Myrna M. Tepora, called the meeting to order upon the affirmation that the quorum was met.
- Twenty-six (26) members of the Academic Council were present during the meeting.

REVIEW OF MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING (February 21, 2022)

• No corrections or comments

Having no further corrections or comments on the Minutes of the Academic Council Meeting on February 21, 2022, the Council moved for its approval and was seconded.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MINUTES

Line 29 to 31. The BOR approved fund 164 budget during the first quarter board meeting.

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TUPC-F-OCD-007Ø Ø (3.14.18)

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 • Line 38 to 40. The TUPC E-Learning Resource Center is about 99% complete and is tentatively scheduled to be inaugurated alongside the TUPC Dome on September 7, 2022.

 • Line 42 to 43. As per the calendar, the scheduled completion of the Admin Bldg. Phase 2 would be in August 2022.

• Line 47 to 49. The local government already granted the campus a permit to conduct limited face-to-face classes on June 8, 2022.

• Line 53 to 54. Coordination with the Barangay Salawag officials has been realized. The barangay sponsored fogging last July 18 and disinfection of the campus last July 25, 2022. Garbage collection is done regularly.

PRESENTATION AND APPROVAL OF CANDIDATES FOR GRADUATION

- Prof. Jay Victor G. Gumboc, Head, Department of Industrial Technology, presented fifty-three (53) candidates for the Bachelor in Graphics Technology major in Architecture Technology, sixty-two (62) candidates for the Bachelor of Engineering Technology major in Civil Technology, six (6) candidates for the Bachelor of Engineering Technology major in Electrical Technology, fifty-three (53) candidates for the Bachelor of Engineering Technology major in Electronics Technology, twenty-six (26) candidates for the Bachelor of Engineering Technology, Electronics Technology Track: Industrial Automation Technology, thirty-eight (38) candidates for the Bachelor of Engineering Technology major in Mechanical Technology, fifty-three (53) candidates for the Bachelor of Engineering Technology, Mechanical Engineering Technology Track: Power Plant Technology, two (2) candidates for the Bachelor of Technology major in Civil Engineering Technology, eight (8) candidates for the Bachelor of Technology major in Computer Engineering Technology.
- Three (3) candidates from the Bachelor of Technology major in Computer Engineering Technology, namely: Gabriel, Katrina J., Pecayo, Elmer S., and Testa, Arvin P., and another one (1) candidate from the Bachelor of Technology major in Power Plant Engineering Technology, Capili, Mark Louise V., were included in the list but lacked clearance.
- Dr. Luis D. Dulnuan Jr., Head of Industrial Relations and Job Placement, suggested allowing the said candidates to graduate on the condition that they have already finished their project and are awaiting the submission of their manuscript.
- Dr. Emily L. Beltran, Head of the Department of Liberal Arts, proposed setting a deadline for the four candidates to submit the manuscript; otherwise, their names would be removed from the list of candidates for graduation.
- Prof. Benefrido B. Reyes inquired whether the students mentioned above had grades in the subject, as the council could not hold their graduation if they had already received their grades.
- As per records from the registrar, the said students already have grades.
- Prof. Gumboc explained that students were allowed to present their thesis at the height of the pandemic, and the manuscript was not required for submitting grades. The manuscript would only be required to be submitted once the students request their school credentials. In the case of the said candidates, they have already finished their defense and were given their grades, although they have yet to submit their manuscripts. These students thought that the same would be applied to them. However, the department

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has strictly imposed the manuscript submission before they are cleared and allowed to graduate. Graduates from previous batches have not yet submitted their manuscripts; according to him, the department was still tracking them.

- Given the situation, Dr. Tepora recommended to the members of the Council to decide whether the said students would be included in the list of candidates for graduation pending the submission of the manuscript on or before the specified date.
- Prof. Maria Cecilia N. Reyes, Assistant Director for Academic Affairs, hoped that such an event would be the last and that next time, the students should be cleared from all the subject requirements, including the manuscript, before they would be given grades. She also suggested that if the council allowed them to retain the names of the said candidates, the following should be the conditions: (1) their clearance would be put on hold; and (2) the rule, "no manuscript, no graduation ceremony," would be applied.
- Prof. Ma. Gemma R. Hufana, Head of the Office of Student Affairs, implied that the Office of the Campus Registrar should not issue the candidates' school credentials.
- The council agreed to include in the list of candidates for graduation the three (3) candidates from the Bachelor of Technology major in Computer Engineering Technology, namely: Gabriel, Katrina J., Pecayo, Elmer S., and Testa, Arvin P., and one (1) candidate from the Bachelor of Technology major in Power Plant Engineering Technology, Capili, Mark Louise V., pending submission of the manuscript not later than August 15, 2022. The Office of the Campus Registrar shall not release all records relative to graduation unless said candidates have submitted the manuscript. Furthermore, they would not be allowed to attend the graduation rites tentatively scheduled on September 8, 2022.
- Prof. Gumboc resumed presenting two (2) candidates from the Bachelor of Technology major in Electronics Engineering Technology, four (4) candidates from the Bachelor of Technology major in Power Plant Engineering Technology, and one (1) candidate from Power Plant Engineering Technology. All candidates were qualified and approved by the Academic Council for graduation.
