DECISION

Factual Antecedents

On May 13, 2021, Dr. Luis D. Dulnuan faculty from the IT Department referred a case to the Head, Office of Student Affairs cases of cheating during the BET ESET remedial midterm examination and remedial quiz that he has administered last May 11, 2021, for the subject EST 3. Finding sufficiency in form and substance, the Office of Student Affairs (OSA) filed the Formal Charge on July 9, 2021, before this Tribunal alleging:

That on May 11, 2021, during the remedial midterm examination and quiz, test papers of thirteen (13) students showed identical answers to the logic circuits which, according to Dr. Dulnuan, do not happen in normal circumstances. The schematic diagrams copy-pasted have the same parts layout, gridline spacing, and parts connections which are indications of cheating.

That on May 13, 2021, the incident was reported to the Office of Student Affairs (OSA) with attached papers of students showing unique layouts and parts connections of the schematic diagrams.

That on May 26, 2021, Mr. Anthony Bungay, former Faculty-In-Charge, Student Discipline recommended to the Head of OSA the complaint filed by Dr. Luis Dulnuan. On May 31, 2021, Mr. Anthony Bungay requested the respondents via email to submit responses. All of the involved students submitted their responses on time with personal explanation on the allegations. All are willing to accept the fair consequences of their individual actions. Based on their responses, ten (10) admitted guilty on the allegation, to wit:

Three (3) among the thirteen (13) respondents who pleaded not guilty are the following:

MS. ROWENA ASILO MR. MATTHEW BELEN MR. ETHAN DANIEL CASTRO

The responses were then forwarded by Mr. Anthony Bungay to the Head of OSA on June 3, 2021.

On July 9, 2021, the OSA Head elevated the case to the Student Disciplinary Tribunal.

With the surge of COVID-19 cases during the 3rd quarter of 2021 and most of the faculty and staff were on quarantine, the Tribunal was not able hold a preliminary conference regarding the case. Observance of safety and health protocols needs to be observed and in addition, members of the Student Disciplinary Tribunal have differing schedules.

On July 26, 2022, the SDT convened for a preliminary conference with Dr. Luis D. Dulnuan to discuss the allegations. The Tribunal agreed to meet the respondents for a hearing together with the Head of OSA and the Guidance Counselor.

With the sudden leave of absence of the Chairman, Engr. Gil Beltran due to an emergency medical procedure, the Tribunal was not able to meet as scheduled.

A feedback slip dated October 24, 2022, was received by Ms. Rosemarie Veluya, SDT Secretary from the Assistant Director for Academic Affairs. With attached letter of request from eleven (11) respondents to expedite deliberation of the case.

The SDT after having met the required quorum convened on November 9, 2022, and deliberated on the responses submitted. On November 18, 2022, the SDT met again to finalize decision on the case.

RULING

Based on the responses ten (10) respondents bearing signatures of their parents/guardians, they voluntarily admitted having committed the offense. This Tribunal hold the following guilty of Academic Dishonesty:

WHEREFORE, premises considered, this Tribunal is convinced to hold the aforementioned respondents liable for the offense of Academic Dishonesty pursuant to the Student Rules of Discipline of the Revised Student Handbook, Major Offense, Sections 14a and 14b and hereby meted the penalty of TEN (10) DAYS SUSPENSION.

A formal hearing will be scheduled for the other three (3) respondents: MS. ROWENA ASILO, MR. MATTHEW BELEN and MR. ETHAN DANIEL CASTRO who pleaded not guilty.
