## History

The establishment of the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP) in Cavite was approved in principle by the Board of Regents on December 6, 1979 per resolution No. 1895 s. 1979, through the initiative of the Vice President Jose Vergara.

The establishment of Cavite campus was response to the demand for an institution of higher learning that could be an avenue for training technician and skilled worker in the fast growing industries in the region.

Technological University of the Philippines at Cavite (TUPC) stands on five - hectare land at Carlos Q. T. Trinidad Avenue in Salawag, Dasmariñas, Cavite donated through the benevolence of Hon. Helena Benitez. A memorandum of agreement between TUP and the Philippine Women's University (PWU) dated February 14, 1981 Where "PWU shall donate five(5) hectares of land to TUP. TUP shall build facilities to house LRC and such other facilities" attested the realization of bringing Technology Education to Cavite.

Upon the release of the General Appropriation Act of 1981, Batas Pambansa 131 and the Deed of Donation in January 1982, operation in the Campus started with Prof. Carlos Trinidad as Executive Director, Dr. Emilita Tacas as Technical Arts Coordinator, and Prof. Dominador Mendoza Jr. as Administrative Coordinator.

TUPC began educating its pioneers of 82 students on July 16, 1982 with 15 faculty members and 10 administrative staff. Initially TUPC offered two-year Technicians Education Programs in the areas of Civil Technology, Electrical Technology, Electronics Technology, Mechanical Technology and Automotive Technology. A year later, it added to its offerings two-year Technical courses in Drafting Technology and Stationary Marine Engineering.

Through the dynamic leadership of Professor Trinidad and strong support of the TUP President Emerita So Pardo, major development took place. Major infrastructures were built to accommodate the growing student population and the increasing number of faculty members and administrative staff. Degree programs were offered to provide help in the professional growth and development of students wanting to be teachers, engineers, technicians, and skilled workers.

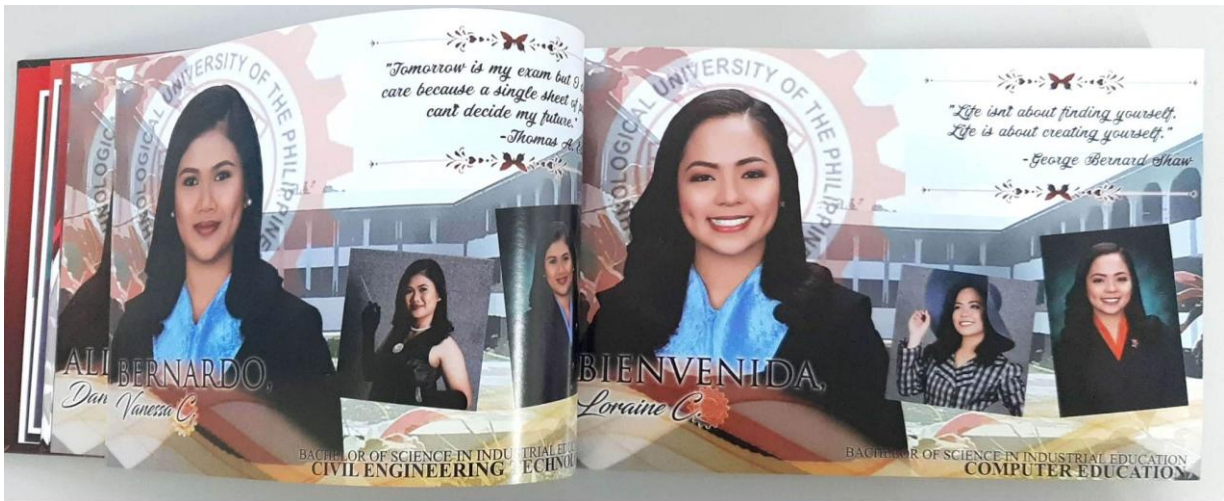

**RESOLUTION NO. 1 s. 2022**

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE GRADUATING STUDENTS OF BATCH 2022 TO HAVE GRADUATION PICTURE, TOGA, GEAR BOOK, MEDALLION AND VENUE**

**WHEREAS**, a survey was conducted by the Seniors Committee regarding the preferences and capabilities of graduating students in availing the graduation picture, toga, and gear book. Furthermore, the survey had 368 responses making up almost all of the estimated graduating students of batch 2022;

**WHEREAS**, based on the survey 95.7% of the respondents agreed on availing the Graduation Picture. While 76.1% of the respondents agreed on availing the Gear Book. Lastly, 95.9% of the respondents agreed on availing the Toga; *(See Annex A for survey results)*

**WHEREAS**, based on a follow-up survey conducted where there are 326 respondents, 95.1% of the graduating students wants to avail the TUPC medallion. Furthermore, with a price range of 500-1500 allotted for graduation venue 92.9% of the respondents agreed on availing; *(See Annex B for survey results)*

**WHEREAS**, all the officers of seniors committee agreed upon availing graduation picture, toga, gear book, medallion, and chosen venue;

**WHEREAS**, the Seniors Committee will be releasing a list of services to avail by the students with corresponding prices accompanied by a waiver of voluntary purchase of preferred services;

**WHEREAS**, the graduating students shall pay directly to the cashier in availing the abovementioned services;

**NOWHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing premises, the undersigned officers and members of Technological University of the Philippines Cavite – University Student Government under Seniors Committee.

**RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVED** that, **A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE GRADUATING STUDENTS OF BATCH 2022 TO HAVE GRADUATION PICTURE, TOGA, GEAR BOOK, MEDALLION AND VENUE** shall be approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that upon approval of this resolution, effectivity shall immediately follow.

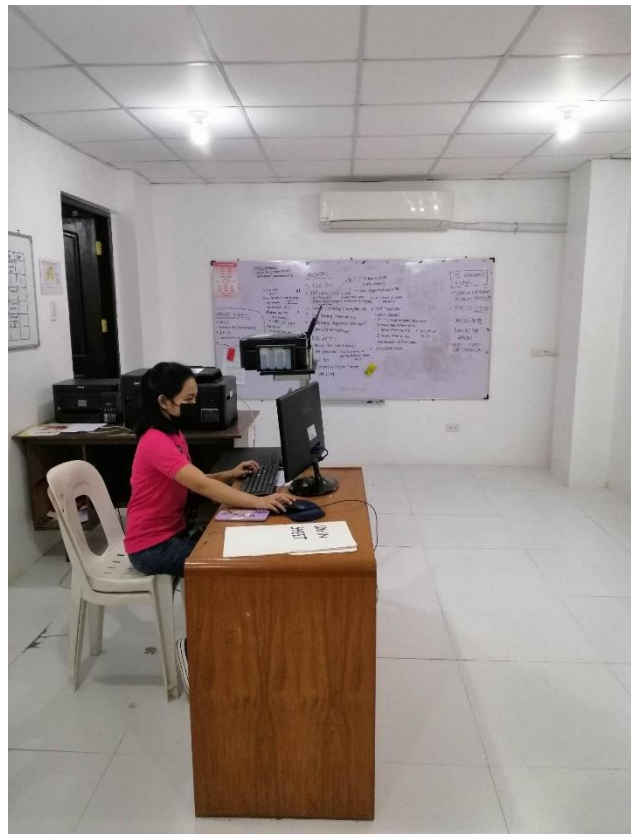
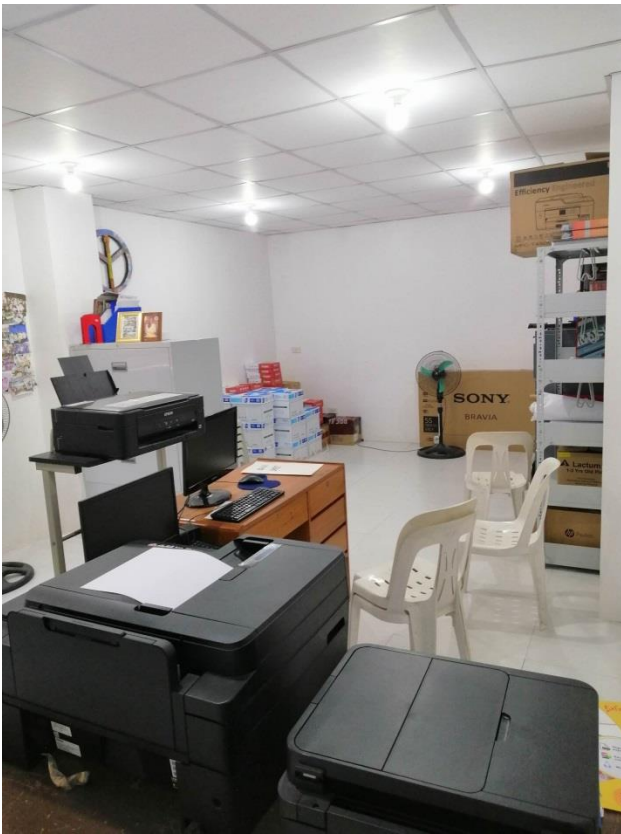
